**WELCOME TO ZION**. It is our hope and prayer that the message you hear today from God's Word will strengthen your faith and fill your heart with the peace only God can give and the joy we have in believing that JESUS CHRIST is our Savior from sin.

**Worship Focus**: As we approach the end of all things and the great day of judgment, we want to make sure that our understanding of the relationship between Christ's work and our work is clear and according to the Word of God. The readings for this Sunday beautifully display that relationship: justification is already perfect and complete, based alone on the grace of God, the merit of Christ, and the promise God has attached to both. Our sanctification is the result of our justification, never and in no way justification's cause. That sanctification, our Christian life in response to the gospel, is progressive and awaits the judgment for its completion.

This is the Second Sunday in the season of End Time. During these four Sundays, the Church focuses on the fulfillment of Christ's promises and encouragement for the Church. We live in the last days and in this season, Jesus wants us to remember his promise, "behold, I am coming soon!" The red paraments for the first two Sundays of the season of End Time are used to remind us of the color of martyrdom and the victorious truth of Christian teaching based on the blood of Christ. The cross on the paraments reminds us of the reason we worship and are able to look forward to the Last Day with longing, instead of dread.




### THE WORD



Second Lesson Hebrews 10:11-18

<sup>11</sup> In the one case, every priest stood ministering day after day, offering the same sacrifices again and again, which are never able to remove sin. <sup>12</sup> In the other case, this priest, after he offered one sacrifice for sins for all time, sat down at the right hand of God. <sup>13</sup> Since then he has been waiting until his enemies are made a footstool under his feet. <sup>14</sup> By only one sacrifice he has made perfect forever those who are being sanctified. <sup>15</sup> The Holy Spirit also testifies in Scripture to us, for first he said: <sup>16</sup> This is the covenant I will make with them after those days, says the Lord.
